- Hot seating of characters from a range of Under the Sea themed texts
- Write a message in a bottle
- Write a letter from the rainbow fish

Mathematics

- Continuation of number awareness and representation
- Number bonds within 10
- Simple addition/subtraction
- Time (days, weeks, months, routine)
- Money (what is money, simple coins)
- Shape (2D/3D)
- Measure – length, height, weight

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Discrete Jigsaw lessons
- Circle time – if I was a dinosaur, what would I eat?
- Circle Time – what type of sea creature would you be and why?
- Explore feelings and choices through stories such as The Snail and the Whale, Boo! A Fishy Mystery.
